Jesus would go to their homes, Sometimes just for a chat, They would sit out in the sun, And talk of this and that.


He told of God's great love for them. They said they were amazed. 'We never knew those things,' they said. To God, they gave their praise.

This week, the children have been hearing about how Jesus healed a man who was paralysed. This man's friends brought him to Jesus because they believed he could help him.




One day, four people brought their friend who couldn't walk to see Jesus.






Then, an old, poor woman came along.






He said, 'The other people put in what they had to spare but this woman gave everything she had.'




